
Week Beginning: 30 September 2019

## **Uniform Policy**

Children may wear watches for telling the time only, no watches that connect to mobile devices are allowed

Plain studs are the only type of earrings to be worn, these must be removed for PE or swimming

All hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back with only a plain blue or black band (no other hair accessories are allowed), no unnatural hair colour or extreme hairstyles please

Nail varnish or tattoos/transfers should not be worn

## **Please Turn off Those Engines!**



... And keep our air around school as clean as possible

On a public road, **it is illegal** to sit in your car whilst keeping the engine running within the UK.

The Highway Code states:

'You **MUST NOT** leave a parked vehicle unattended with the engine running or leave a vehicle engine running unnecessarily while that vehicle is stationary on a public road'. An idling engine can produce up to twice the emissions of a car that's in motion. The fumes contain many harmful gases that contribute to global warming and medical conditions such as asthma.
