Published admission number (PAN)

The published admission number for entry to the academy in the reception year is 30.

Oversubscription criteria

1	Looked after children and previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
2	Children who live in the catchment area and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the academy.
3	Children who live outside the catchment area and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the academy.
4	Children of staff who have been employed at the academy for at least 2 years and/or are recruited to fill a demonstrable skill shortage.
5	Other children who live in the catchment area at the closing date for applications.
6	Children who live outside the catchment area but who are attending the academy nursery class on the closing date for applications.
7	Other children who live outside the catchment area.
