Phonics Curriculum Overview

Bracken Lane Primary Academy follows the Read Write Inc Programme for the teaching of phonics and early reading from Reception to Year 2. Read Write Inc lessons take place each morning across Early Years and Key Stage 1. The Read Write Inc philosophies are embedded in the teaching and learning of reading and writing throughout the curriculum.

The use of this synthetic phonics programme ensures that all children are taught:

- phonemic awareness (the sounds that make up words such as c/a/t);
- the sound–spelling relationships in words;
- how to say the sounds that make up words;

and to do this by:

- using texts that are made up of words that use the sound–spelling relationships children have learned;
- using interesting and authentic stories to develop vocabulary and language comprehension.

Children are assessed regularly and placed in groups according to their assessment. This ongoing assessment of children’s phonics progress is sufficiently frequent and detailed to identify any child who is falling behind the programme’s pace. If they do fall behind, targeted support is given immediately.
